

BEING His Disciples Indeed

“...John stood with two of his disciples.

The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following said,

‘What do you seek?’ They said to Him, ‘Master, where are you staying?’ (*Where do You abide?*)

He said to them, *‘Come and see!’*

(John 1:35-39)

Mark lists the 12 He chose:

“And he went up on the mountain and called to Him those He Himself wanted. And they came to Him. Then He appointed twelve that they might be with Him, and that He might send them out to preach, and to have power to heal sicknesses and to cast out demons.” (Mark 3:13-15)

“Abide in Me, and I in you.”

“As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in Me. I am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him bears much fruit. For without Me you can do nothing.”

(John 15:4,5)

Three Phases of Growth for every disciple:

1) The **Carnal** Disciple:

1 Corinthians 3:1-3

2) The **Companion** Disciple:

John 21:1-6

3) The **Communion** Disciple:

John 13:23

Carnal Disciple

- **Newborn**
- **Immature**
- **Undeveloped**
- **Not fully formed**
- **Childish**
- **Milk, not Meat**
- **Not excited about growth!**

- Can be quite zealous at times
- Not always concerned with reproduction or the responsibility thereof



Communion Disciple

- “Now there was leaning on Jesus’ bosom one of his disciples whom Jesus loved.” (John 13:23)
- Communion disciples are aware that there is **SOMETHING MORE.**




As a Communion Disciple:

- 1- He **convinces** me of His love (John 13:23)
- 2- He **converses** with me (John 13:23 & 21:7)
- 3- He **constrains** me to stand when I would otherwise fall (John 18:15-18)
- 4- He **confides** in me; (trusts me with what's dear to Him) (Jn. 19:26,27)

Branch: Stay ON (in) the VINE!

- **“ Remain in Me, and I in you. Just as the branch is unable to produce fruit by itself unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in Me. I am the Vine; you are the branches. The one who remains in Me and I in him produces much fruit, because you can do nothing without Me.”** (John 15:4,5; Holman Translation)

A Disciple is a follower of Jesus:
