- ▶ A. real time
- ▶ /,rē(ə)l 'tīm/
- ▶ noun: **real time**; noun: **realtime**
- ▶ 1. the actual time during which a process or event occurs.
- ▶ "along with much of the country, he watched events unfolding **in real time** on TV"
- ▶ 2. COMPUTING
- ▶ relating to a system in which input data is processed within milliseconds so that it is available virtually immediately as feedback, e.g., ig., in a missile guidance or airline booking system.

II. Biblical Terms of Time

- ▶ **In the Fullness of time:** Within the appropriate or destined **time**, as in We'll know if it's a boy or a girl in the **fullness of time**. This expression employs **fullness** in the sense of “a complete or ample measure or degree.” [Early 1600s] i.e., birth following 9 months gestation. Galatians 4:4

- ▶ **Appointed time:** If something happens at the **appointed time**, it happens at the **time** that was decided in advance. [formal] i.e., Dr. Appointments; Galatians 4:2

relating to the current period of time.
"the story takes place in present-time Britain" , i.e. distinguished from past time and future time, now. Rom. 8:18

- ▶ ¹⁶ You saw me before I was born.
Every day of my life was recorded in your book.
Every moment was laid out
before a single day had passed.

- ▶ Job 14:5 New King James Version (NKJV)
- ▶ ⁵ Since his days *are* determined,
The number of his months *is* with You;
You have appointed his limits, so that he cannot pass.

A. Example: Jeremiah

- ▶ Jeremiah 1:5 New King James Version (NKJV)
- ▶ ⁵ “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you;
Before you were born I sanctified^[a] you;
I ^[b]ordained you a prophet to the nations.”

A. Example: Samson

- ▶ Now there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren and had no children. ³ And the Angel of the LORD appeared to the woman and said to her, “Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son. ⁴ Now therefore, please be careful not to drink wine or *similar* drink, and not to eat anything unclean. ⁵ For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.”
- ▶ ¹² Manoah said, “Now let Your words come *to pass!* What will be the boy’s rule of life, and his work?”

A. Example: John the Baptist

- ▶ Luke 1:13-17 New King James Version (NKJV)
- ▶ ¹³ But the angel said to him, “Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.
- ▶ ¹⁴ And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth.
- ▶ ¹⁵ For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother’s womb.
- ▶ ¹⁶ And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God.
- ▶ ¹⁷ He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, ‘to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,’ and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.”

- ▶ ³⁰ Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. ³² He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³ And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.”
